About Google Docs file size limits and storage capacity:

- Basic (student/staff/faculty) Google Docs account is limited to 5 Gb of free storage. (Paid Google Drive accounts offer additional storage capacity.)
- Files uploaded and converted to Google Documents — 2 mb file size limit.
- Spreadsheets uploaded and converted to Google Spreadsheet format — 20 mb file size limit.
- Drawings (Images), no specified file size limitation.
- Other files, anything uploaded and not converted to Google Docs, Sheets or Slides format can be up to 10 Gb in size, but will require additional storage capacity.
