The vessel shown on the reverse side of this card is the "Vesuvius." Keel laid in 1887. Tonnage, 929; speed in knots, 21.4; horse-power, 3794; length on load water line, 252 feet; extreme breadth, 26.6 feet; mean draught, 10.1 feet. Complement, 6 officers and 64 men.

The Batteries consist of three 15-in dynamite guns, three 3-pounder rapid fire rifles.
